

Horizon Christian School Student Dress Code

Horizon aims to foster a productive learning environment through modest, neat, and appropriate attire that supports educational goals and reflects excellence.

General Standards

Students are required to wear clothing that is neat (clean, tidy, no holes), modest (not tight, loose, or revealing), and appropriate for the setting (classroom, athletics, formal).

Special dress-up days may be scheduled.

Tops

Collared shirts with sleeves (button-down or polo, solid color or repeating pattern, no camo or animal prints)

Sweaters

Solid color crew neck sweatshirts

Vests

Official Horizon Hawk wear (including Hawk hoodies)

No large logos or graphics; small manufacturers or Horizon logos are acceptable

Secondary: Girls may wear collarless blouses.

Bottoms

Solid-color or repeating pattern, office-style pants/shorts; no camo or animal print; no rips, frays, or holes

Girls: skirts, dresses (sleeves required), and jumpers must be near knee-length;

 jumpsuits need a defined waist or belt (no overalls)

 leggings/spandex only under skirts/dresses/jumpers

Elementary: Blue jeans are allowed on Fridays only and if worn with red dress code top

Secondary: Blue jeans allowed daily

Accessories & Footwear

Must be moderate and understated

No flip-flops, slides, croc-style shoes, or stiletto heels

Hats/sunglasses not allowed indoors

Girls: Earrings allowed (no other piercings); Makeup must look natural

Boys: No piercings

Elementary: No open-toed shoes

Outerwear (Coats and Jackets)

Must be neat and understated; small logos allowed

No hoods/hats indoors

Not worn in classrooms

Hair

Neat, natural hair colors only; no extreme styles; out of eyes

Boys: Above shoulders, trimmed sideburns/facial hair, no accessories

Swimwear

Must be modest

Girls: One-piece or tankini (no midriff) or modest two-piece with dark t-shirt

PE & Athletics

Clothing must fit properly and cover undergarments

Spandex/compression shorts/leggings/yoga pants may only be worn under shorts

Friday Spirit Days

Elementary: Red dress code shirts or Horizon Hawk wear

Secondary: Red, black, or white dress code shirts or Horizon Hawk wear

Formal Wear

Boys: Suits or tuxedos with ties or bowties

Girls: Formal dresses that modestly cover the chest, stomach, lower back, and legs; dresses may be sleeveless, or spaghetti strap; modest strapless dresses may also be approved by administration

Enforcement

Students must resolve dress code issues respectfully without creating problems for others.

Non-compliance may result in removal from class, special assignments, and/or parent contact.
